Your child learns the most important rules in dealing with the dog. Anxious children are particularly well looked after. I am always present and ensure safe and fear-free encounters between child and dog.

Leaflet for the start of kindergarten

- Mugs or Cups with names
- Slippers (leather slippers are the most durable)
- Diapers need: diapers, wet wipes, gloves (we are only allowed to use latex-free gloves)
- possibly a pacifier or a cuddly animal (in a box)
- Gym clothes (leggings or shorts, T-shirt, slippers)
- Kindergarten bag and / or backpack with chest strap for trips
- easy-to-open lunch box
- rubber boots (according to the season)
- Rainwear (rain jacket or mud pants)
- 5 euros for cloth bags and portfolio
- clothes to change

Also worth knowing

Of course, we support your child in the things that they cannot do on their own. But it will be very proud if it can put on and take off its clothes independently, like the grown-ups, etc.

Help your child by choosing things that can largely control himself

If possible, mark everything with the name of your child. This makes it easier for you and us to search for and assign
